Items made at these workshops will be eligible to be entered into the Fair as a 4-H Project. **Sign up early, space is limited** (low enrollment will result in the class being cancelled—deadline is 1 week prior to the date class starts).

*Youth not currently enrolled in 4-H pay a one-time \$25 enrollment fee for the 2018/2019 4-H Year that begins October 1, 2018 thru September 30, 2019, in addition to the workshop fee, payable at time of registration. Financial need scholarships are available.
